Long-term volunteers will live and work like local people.

3. Training courses, seminars and conferences

SJ Vietnam organizes regular workshops, seminars, conferences and training for its members, which provide young volunteers with knowledge in global education including conflict management, leadership, intercultural learning and volunteering skills, etc.

4. Sending Vietnamese volunteers abroad

Through a network of international partners, SJ Vietnam offers Vietnamese volunteers chances to join in workcamps, projects and EVS abroad.

Background

There are so many children, as young as two, selling lottery tickets on the streets of Ho Chi Minh City. Families sacrificed their children' education just to make ends meet. We need to advocate for children' quality of life and their right to education. CVI is a learning center for disadvantage children, homelesschildren, those were born in poor family to have a chance to learn how to read and write in Vietnamese. Ky Quang Orphanage is run by Ky Quang Pagoda, which was built in the early part of the 20th Century in 1924. The pagoda is now a place of charity for unlucky children and also helps treat diseases. Now, the pagoda is taking care and bringing up more than 200 children in the South of Vietnam. The children here have unfortunate backgrounds as many have been abandoned by their parents and relatives most of them have suffering from cerebral-palsy, blindness or Down's syndrome, Agent Orange.

We - SJ Vietnam would like to bring little good things to these community in our society, we would like to share with them the happiness and support their life.

Volunteers will carry out English lesson through different non-formal activities such as games, music, art, sport, etc... for children at learning center. Besides that, the volunteers clean and beautify the classroom, taking care of mini garden where the teachers plant some vegetable to add in their children's meal-break.

Background

CEC (Continual Educational Center) is an English environment for children from 6 – 15 years old.

Volunteers will be English teachers who will make lesson plan, teach in classes every day. More importantly, volunteers are encouraged to help the children to engage with English through games, songs, sport, music, etc. During the summer, the children will have more free time as they do not need to go for school, volunteers will organize workshops and summer camp for the children. Besides, volunteers will join and organize events such as English club, visiting trips to explore and learn about the city with the children. This is an opportunity for both volunteers and children to get to know each other better and have great time together discovering one of the most beautiful coastline in Vietnam. By these activities, we also hope that both volunteers and children treasure our nature, then have practicals actions to limit the negative impact to environment.

Phu Yen encompasses a diverse landscape of mountains, rivers, lagoons and fertile plains with nearly 200 kilometres of shoreline along Vietnam's curving south-central coast. Aside from that, Phu Yen is also famous for its amazingly delicious cuisine.

Background

The mission of Phuc Tue Centre is to help disabled childrens become more independent in their everyday life by building their self-confidence. At the centre we aim to help educate and recover mental health, as well as provide development and vocational skill training to help integrate these individuals into the employment community. This not only allows these individuals to feel independent in their everyday life but this will also diminish the potential burden on the family and society

Currently, the center has 60 disabled childrens with ailments including Down's Syndrome, Cerebral Palsy, Autism, children who have been victims of Agent Orange, as well as other mental illnesses. The Centre has applied the specific education measures which ae suited for each individual and has used psychotherapy methods in attempts to rehabilitate the mentally.

The Fisher village is a place that consists of more than 40 families live in temporary ragged boats on Red river (half of them live on the bank of the river called "Fisher Village" while the other half live in the island of the river named "Fisher Island"). All of them are extremely poor, have no job in their hometowns. They come to Hanoi to get a job for earning more money for their life, families and children. However, in fact that in city everything is expensive and it is not easy to have a job which gives them enough money to have normal life. So, they have to accept hard and bad jobs to have

money enough to survive. Some of them collect rubbish on the street, dumping ground, be carrier in Long Bien market, etc. They do not have enough money to rent a flat or house on the land in city, so they have to live on boats on the Red River between rubbish. (So, they are actually not fishermen, we call Fisher village just because they are living on the river!). Their children, all of whom were badly malnourished and illiterate (but they can go to the schools since several years ago thanks to the great support from SJV and some international volunteers to get their birth certificate and ID!), have to sell collected fruits, vegetable, lottery results or catch shrimp overnight. Background

Buoc-village is a small village of Thai-people (an ethnic group came from southern of China) with very pure landscape. As you can see on the above map, this area is placed by only green color and a lot of mountain. Because of this natural condition, Thaipeople here rely mainly on agriculture. In the past, the village was located adjacent to streams and people in the village used water of the stream for gardening. During the rainy season water from the mountain goes down through the streams and washes everything away, making it very dangerous to live close to the stream. For this reason, the government has helped residents here to move to higher lands, and build permanent \traditional houses with wood. 10 years have passed since the new BUOC-village was reconstructed in 2002. Currently, firm houses, concrete roads, electricity have become the basic-living-condition of every villager. Although the stream is very beautiful it is dangerous. Despite the good aspects of new infrastructure, villagers still lack a lot of education and understanding about modern society. Therefore, it would be very helpful to help and stay with BUOC-villagers.

Background

Cat Ba is the largest of the 366 islands spanning 260km2 that comprise the Cat BaArchipelago, which makes up the southeastern edge of Ha Long Bay in Northern Vietnam.

Cat Ba is the largest island in the Bay and approximately half of its area is covered by a National Park, which is home to the highly endangered Cat Ba Langur. The island has a wide variety of natural ecosystems, both marine and terrestrial, leading to incredibly high rates of biodiversity. Types of natural habitats found on Cat Ba Archipelago include limestone karsts, tropical limestone forests, coral reefs, mangrove and sea grass beds, lagoons, beaches, caves, and willow swamp forests.

For all of its natural beauty, Cat Ba Island faces numerous environmental problems. Increases in tourism and recent developments threaten the ecological integrity and biodiversity of the island, reducing and fragmenting the natural habitat for Cat Ba's numerous species. Illegal hunting and poaching, overfishing, and water pollution in Ha Long Bay continue to threaten the ecological health of the island. The island is a national park of Vietnam and was



recognized by UNESCO in December 2004 as a Biosphere reserve of the world.

Organize activities for the children from the village nearby, small renovation at school if needed, activities to raise awareness of youth and local people about environment, climate change, protect white-headed langur at Cat Ba National park, etc. Organized educational activities for children related to environmental activities.

Background

Christmas is not listed as a Vietnamese official holiday but we still celebrate that day in Vietnam since Vietnam used to be part of the French Empire and there are still French influences in the Christmas traditions. Many Catholic churches have a big nativity crib scene or 'creche' with nearly life size statues of Mary, Joesph, baby Jesus, the shepherds and animals. In some areas of Ho Chi Minh City, usually in Catholic parishes, people have big crib scenes in front of their houses and decorate the whole street, turning it into a Christmas area! These are popular for people to visit and look at the scenes.

We - SJ Vietnam try our very best to "bring" Santa Clause, whose are our international volunteers to the disadvantage children (orphans, disabled, intellectual, hospital patients, the homeless and the poor) to share and to build up their dream. Children can be born in different situation but they need to live in an equal environment and we are here to create that environment.

Background

Tết, or Vietnamese New Year, is the most important celebration inVietnamese culture. The word is a shortened form of Tết Nguyên Đán, which is Sino-Vietnamese for "Feast of the First Morning of the First Day". Tết celebrates the arrival of spring based on the Vietnamese variation of the Chinese lunisolar calendar, which usually has the date falling between the months of January or February

It takes place from the first day of the first month of the Vietnamese calendar (around late January or early February) until at least the third day. Many Vietnamese prepare for Tét by cooking special holiday foods and cleaning the house. These food includes Chung cake (bánh chưng), bánh dày, dried young bamboo soup (canh măng), giò and sticky rice. There are a lot of customs practiced during Tét, such as visiting a person's house on the first day of the new year (xông nhà), ancestral worshipping, wishing New Year's greetings, giving lucky money to children and elderly people, and opening a shop.

Tết is also an occasion for pilgrims and family reunions. During Tết, Vietnamese visit their relatives and temples, forgetting about the troubles of the past year and hoping for a better upcoming year. They consider

Tết to be the first day of spring and the festival is often called Hội xuân (spring festival).

SJV- L1905 Bring Smiles to orphans and interacting with poor students

Ky Quang Orphanage is run by Ky Quang Pagoda, which was built in the early part of the 20th Century in 1924. The pagoda is now a place of charity for unlucky children and also helps treat diseases. Now, the pagoda is taking care and bringing up more than 200 children in the South of Vietnam. Their ages ranges from 5 days old to 40 years old. 90 percent of these are orphans that are suffering from cerebral-palsy, blindness or Down's syndrome, Agent Orange. The children here have unfortunate backgrounds as many have been abandoned by their parents and relatives. Every few months, the monks find a new baby left in front of the pagoda gate. The head monk sometimes receives phone calls from hospitals requesting him to take in abandoned babies. At present, about 30-40 local children have a chance to study at Ky Quang as some local teachers teach Vietnamese for them in the morning.



<u>CVI</u> is a learning center for disadvantage children, homeless children, those were born in poor family to have a chance to learn how to read and write in Vietnamese. That is the basic need for children as their age. Besides that, CVI provides opportunity for them to develop their life skills. At present the center has been accepted about 40 kids around the area. We believe every child deserves an education, w empower the next generation, to choose a world full of compassion.

<u>Co May Dormitory</u> was built on purpose of generating good condition for poor and good students. It provides free dorm and other facilities for students who are studying at universities located in

Ho Chi Minh City. We believe that with support from Co May, the student will concentrate on studying to become good citizen then contribute in development of country..
