PROJECT	construction.
AIMS OF THE PROJECT	This program is dedicated to true nature lovers who want to contribute to one
	of the biggest problems of our environment and society.
	Our main objective is the protection and conservation of two different
	ecosystems: the coast and the cloudy forest.
PROJECT'S ACTIVITIES	The group will clean the beach; pick up the garbage that comes to the beach
	carried by the wind and marine currents. In addition, raise awareness about
	the impact of garbage in the community.
	To do water basin conservation in the Reserve and help in the maintenance
	of the paths. Participants will learn and help to plant an orchard. We also will
	support in the renovation of the rooms for the volunteers.
COMMUNITY CONTEXT	The community of Ligüiqui is located in a small town of 350 people
	approximately, their main activity used to be fishing but nowadays
	they live from tourism. This little town is located close to the natural
	reserve of Pacoche and a protected marine area; it is a very important
	place for archeology.
	Through our work in the reserve, we contribute to the community by
	doing conservation of the cloudy forest, which is the source of water

	for the population living downstream.
VOLUNTEER'S	- To be able to adapt to a modest accomodation
REQUIREMENTS	- To be able to adapt to live in the forest with no
	communications and internet.
	- To be able to do physical work.
	- To have contact with soil and get dirty.
VOLUNTEER'S TASKS	- To help in the cleaning of beaches and towns.
	- To help in the environmental awareness activities with the
	community.
	- To help in cleaning paths in the forest.
	- To help in planting trees.
	- To help with maintenance and renovation work.
HOST SITUATION	Accommodation is modest at the beach; food will be provided prepared by
	people from the community.
	There are basic services like current water, energy but there is no phone
	signal or internet.
	In the reserve, the accommodation is comfortable; there is no current water,
	nor internet or phone signal.
	It is a good opportunity to disconnect yourself from the daily life and relax
	in a friendly and intercultural environment.
	The group will travel from place to place in public transportation with the
	mentor or coordinator of the project.
HOW TO ARRIVE	You will arrive to the Fundación Proyecto Ecologico Chiriboga office
	and shelter in Quito, to get to our office from the airport is possible
	to come by bus or by taxi.
	The cost of the taxi is 30 dollars until 22:00pm and 35 dollars after
	this hour.
	The cost of the bus is 2.50 dollars and is possible to take this bus from
	07:00am to 19:00pm before or after this time there are no buses, the
	route is AIRPORT- TERMINAL QUITUMBE when the volunteer
	arrives to the Terminal Quitumbe, and if he/she has more than a back
	pack, is necessary to take a taxi (\$5.00 dollares max.) to come home,
